**In this newsletter, we are pleased to share with you an overview of the learning and activities that took place during February.**



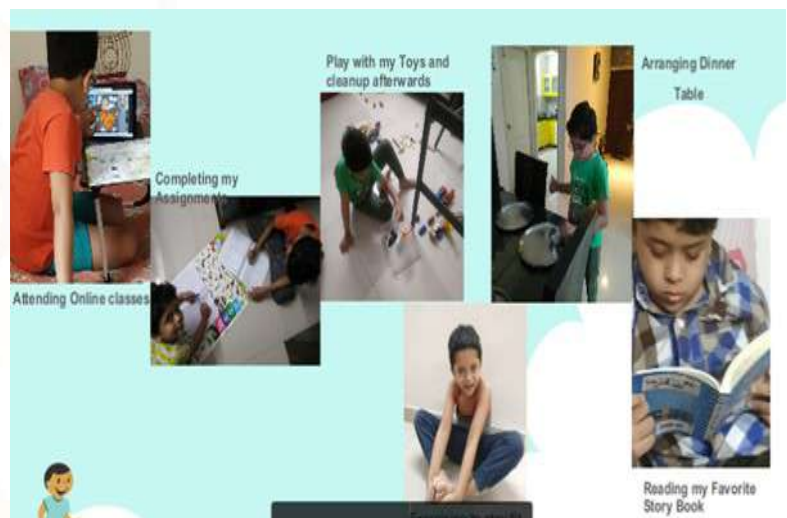

**We wish to applaud all our learners who once again braved the unprecedented learning scenario and optimized virtual classroom learning by following rules and guidelines.**

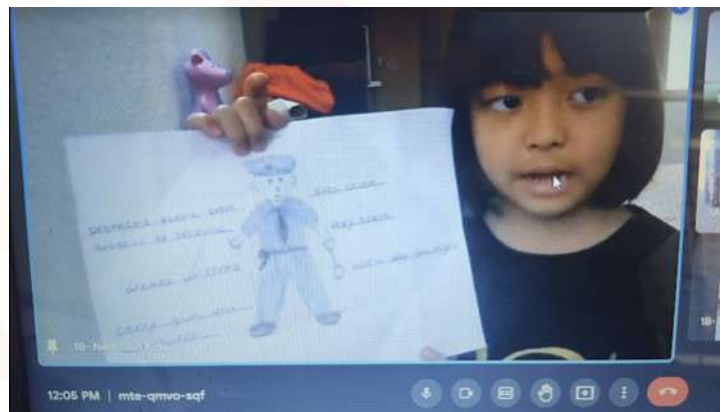
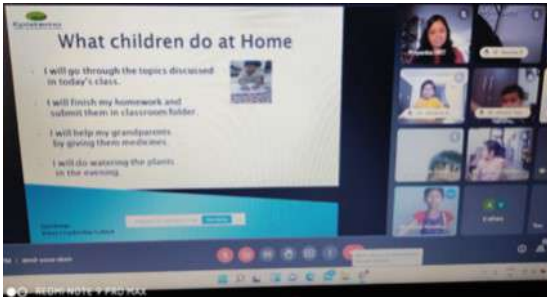

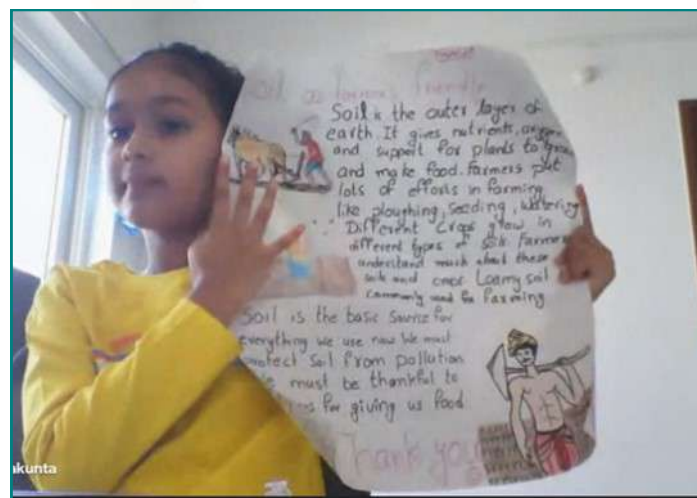
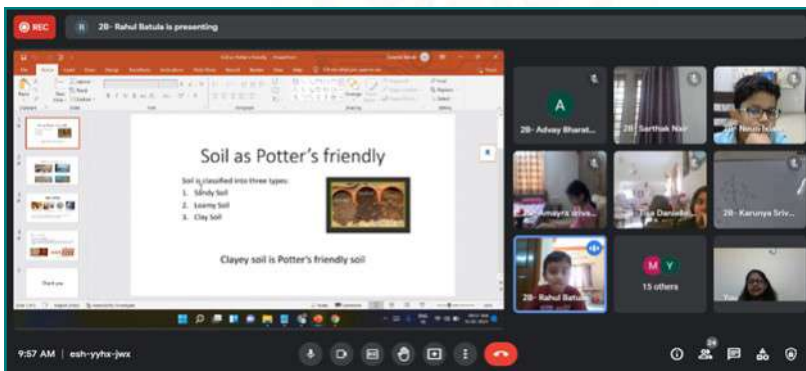
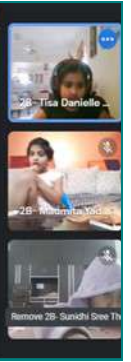
- Soil is the most essential element for existence of life on earth

Grade 3 students presented their activities done in the second term and also shared their skills they developed in the process like research, analysis, evaluation, collaboration, communication and above all **reflection**.

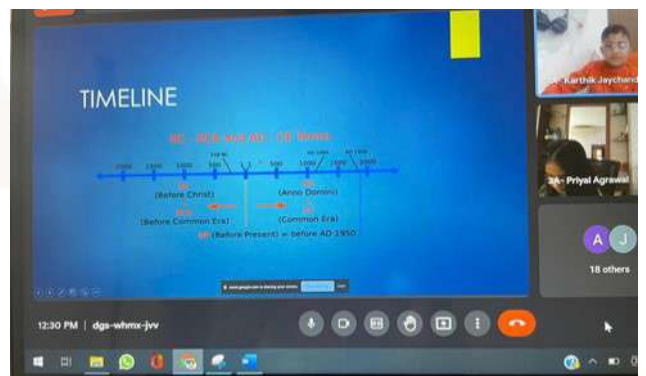
**The topics were -Traditional Cuisine, studying our past, Early Humans, why do we need Rules and Our Government.**

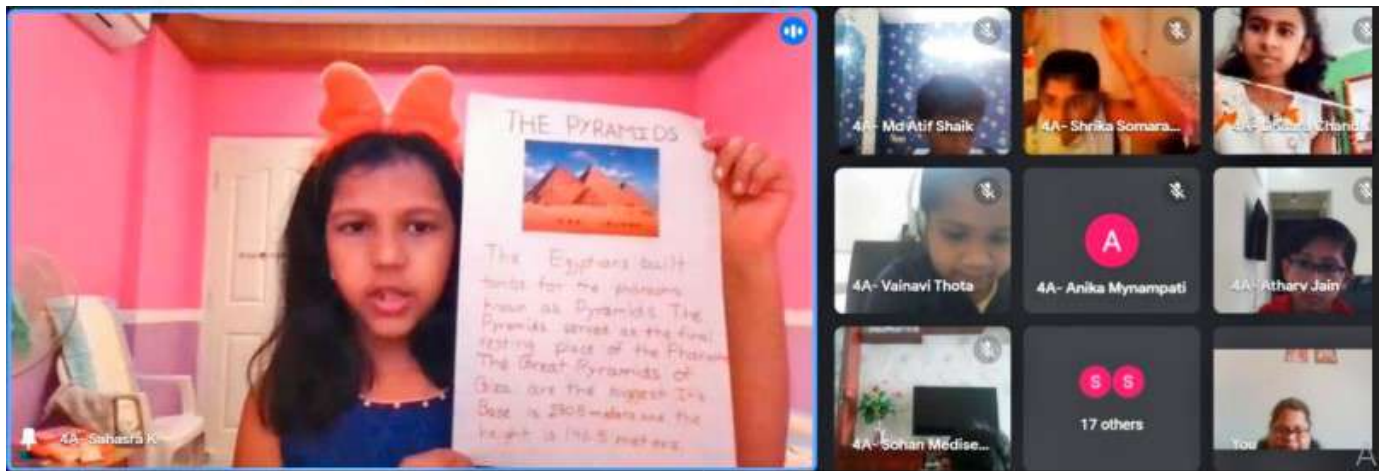




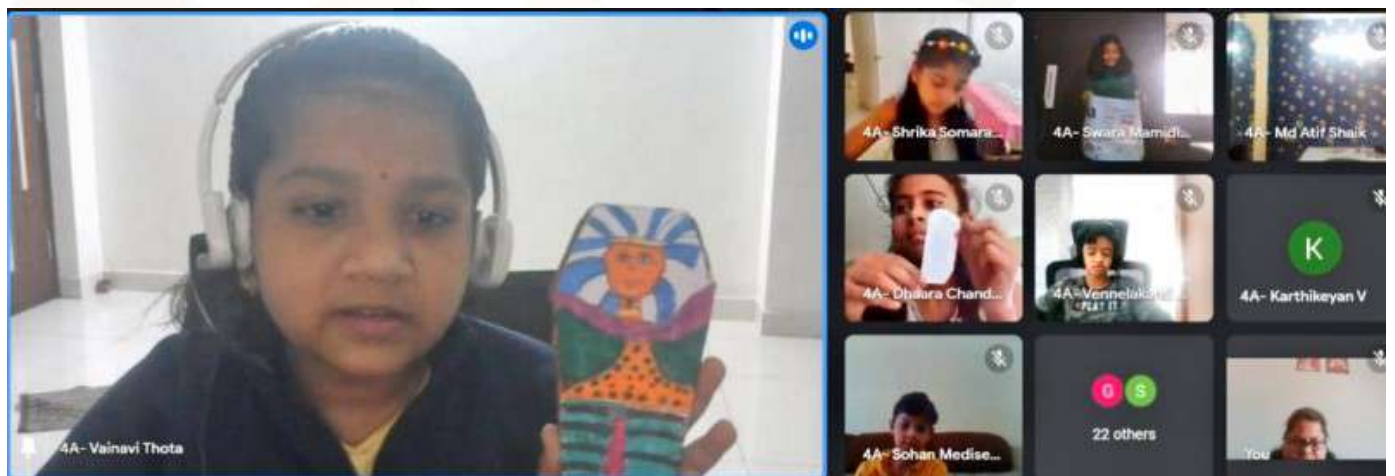
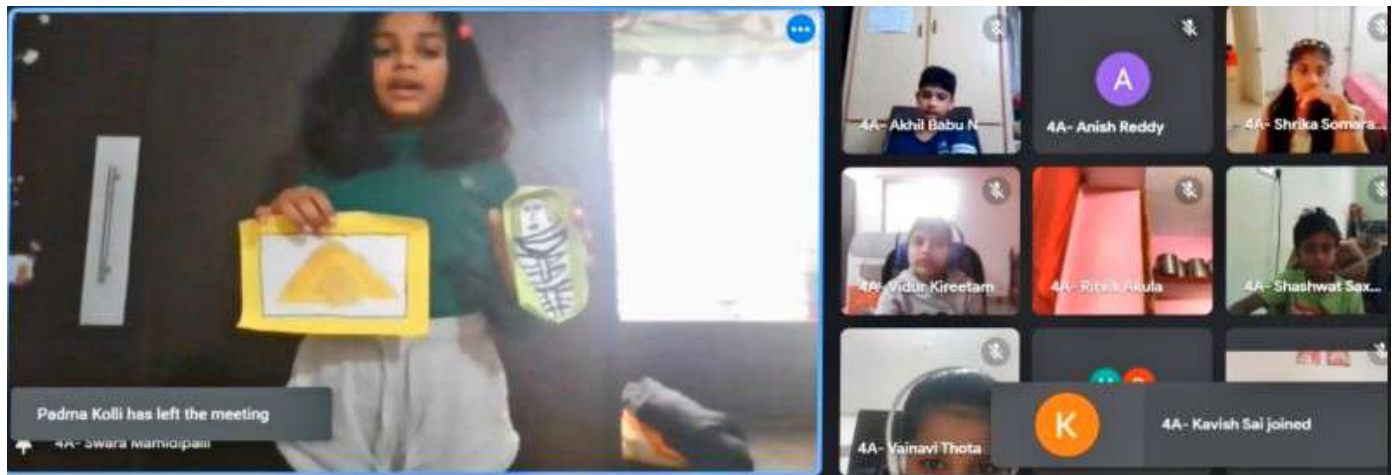
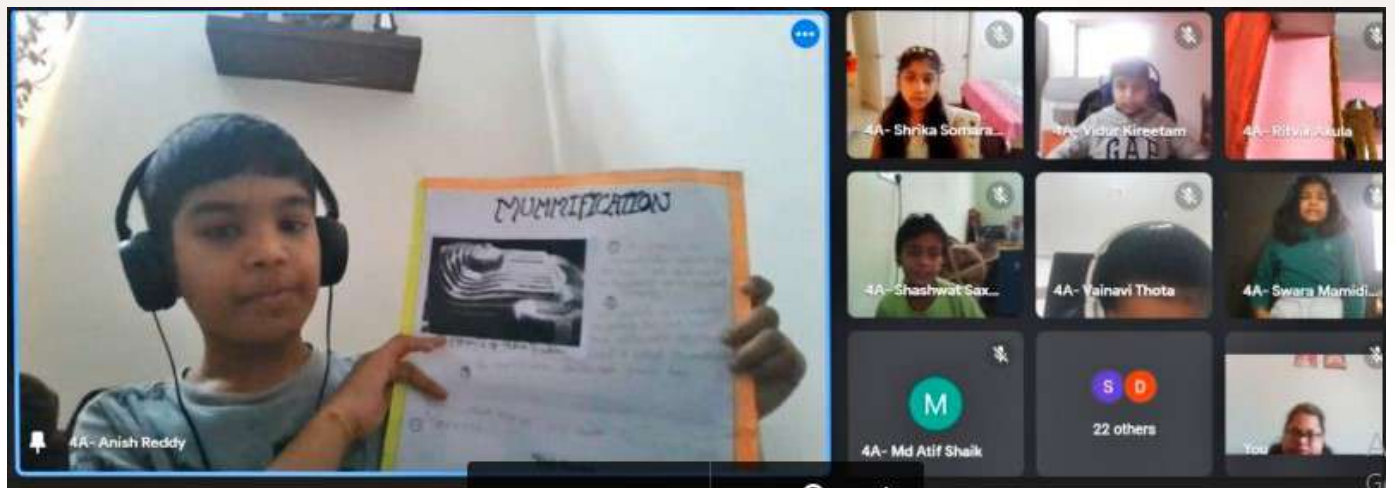
## Grade 4 - GP Reflection Day

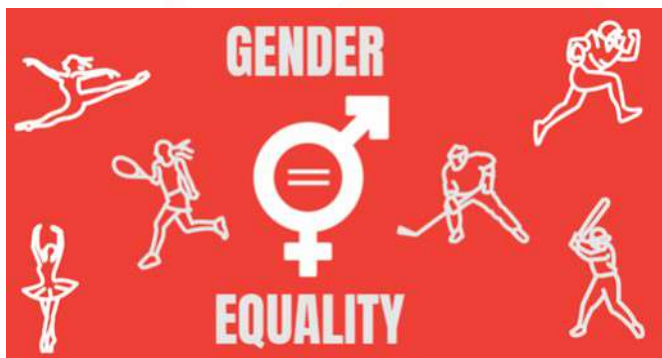


## Grade - 8

Students develop posters based on Sustainable development goals. It's an opportunity to share their work with a broader audience here.

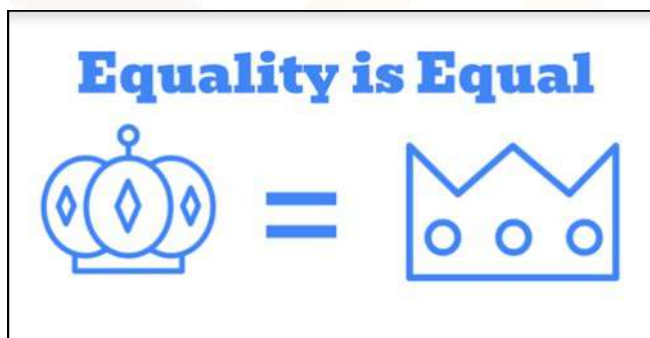
